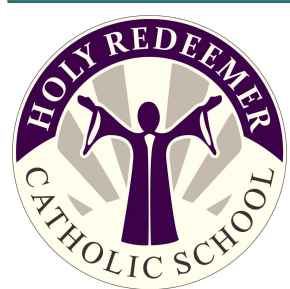

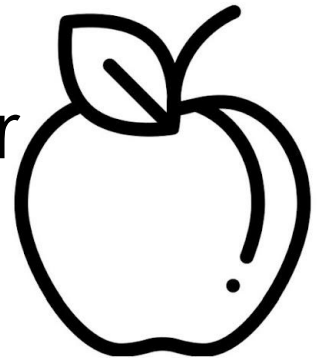


I love teaching! This is going to be my 24th year in teaching and I'm so excited for this coming year . I am married and have 3 beautiful children!

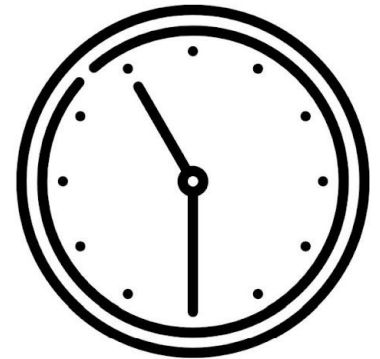

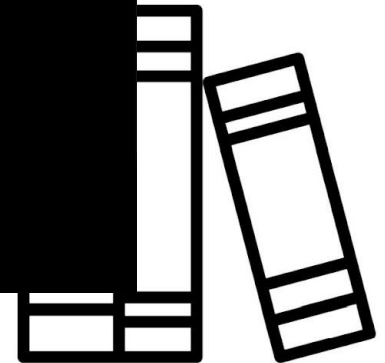
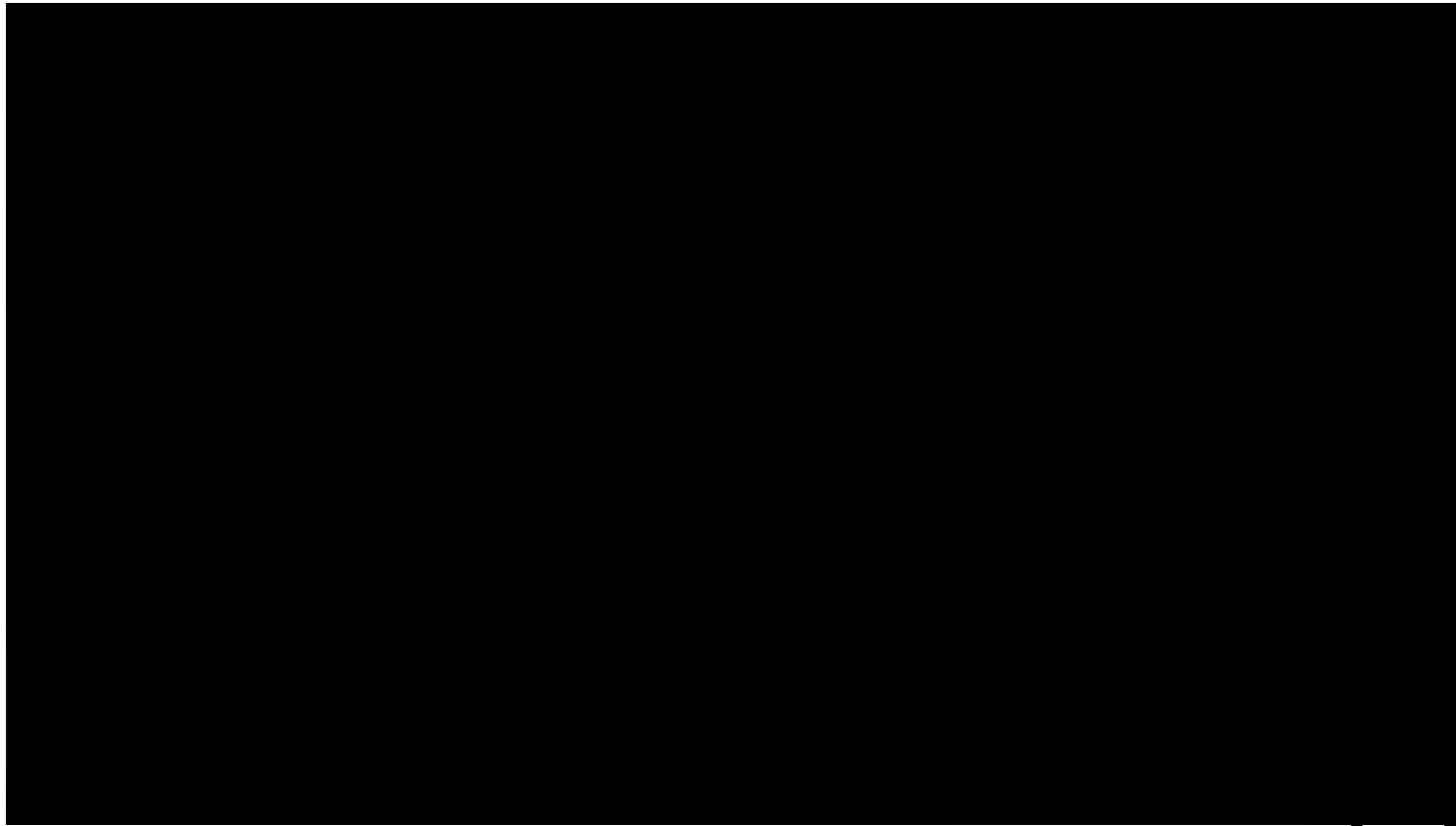

- Please keep all toys at home!

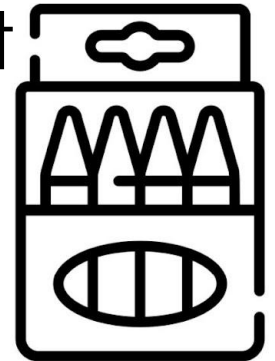


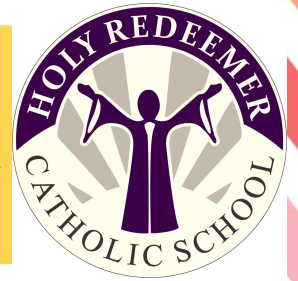


SCHOOL *Supplies*

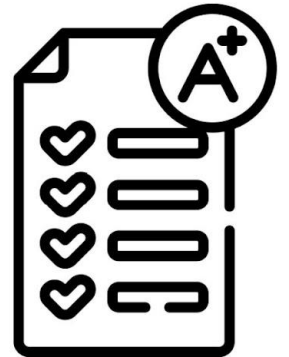


GRADING Policy

There will be a Kindergarten Newsletter and year calendar emailed to you in August for Kindergarten days. Please print out at home to keep on hand!

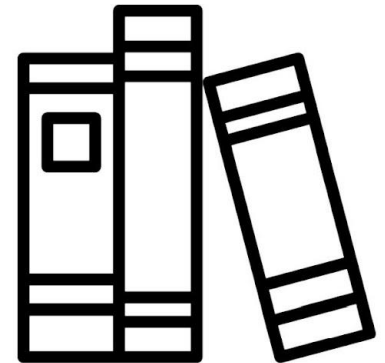
Each month you will receive a Kindergarten calendar and a newsletter.



Kindergarten Readiness



- Have basic health and hygiene skills in place? (i.e., Using the bathroom, washing hands, using a tissue, covering a sneeze, dressing themselves, etc.)
- Play well with other children, take turns, care about the feelings of others, share, cooperate, say please and thank you
- Follow two- or three-step directions
- Express feelings in a safe way
- Clean up toys or work areas when it is time to complete projects
- Know their full name, address, phone number
- Know the names of body parts
- Know their age and birthday



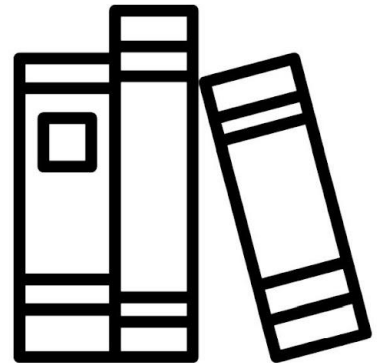
Seesaw

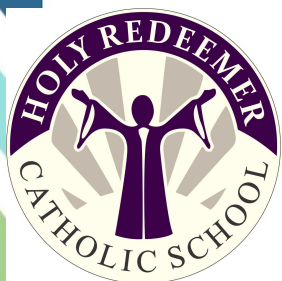


Please download the Seesaw Family app. Our K-4 team uses this as our main way to share reminders and pictures of your child's learning with families.
